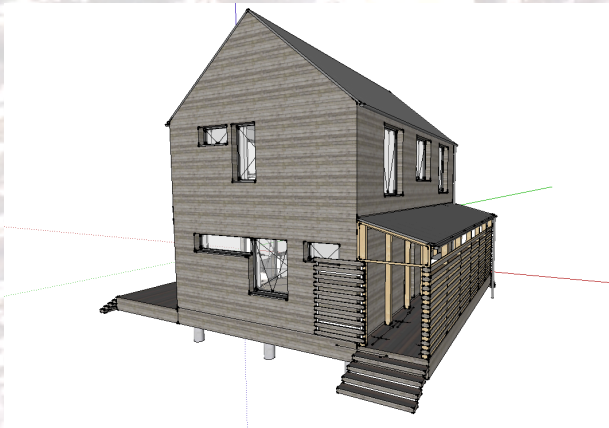


Eco friendly design
